WOODALL COUNTRY HOUSE SAFARIS AND TOURS – Minimum for 2 persons

Woodall's luxury open topped land cruiser departs daily on a number of excursions. Our highly experienced and qualified guides have an intimate knowledge of the Addo area. These guides offer personalised tours with emphasis being placed on individual interests and comfort. The following highly recommended Safaris and Drives are offered: Children 6+ years welcome. For younger children a private safari can be arranged

Morning Drive: Summer (08h00 - 12h30) / winter (08h00 - 12h30)

Afternoon Drive: Summer (14h00 - 18h30) / winter (14h00 - 18h00)

ADDO ELEPHANT NATIONAL PARK

Addo is the best place to get up close and personal with the biggest land mammal - the Park is home to the densest population of elephant in the world. Other mammals include Lion, Hyaena, Cape buffalo, and Black Rhino, as well as Zebra, Jackal, Warthog, Suricate and numerous species of Antelope. Over 150 bird species have been recorded in Addo and there are around 600 different plant species. Addo is also home to the endangered dung beetle.

Whether you experience the park from the comfort of your own vehicle or on a game drive with an experienced guide, the chances are you will have close encounters with the elephant. To make the most of the park, be sure to bring binoculars, camera, walking shoes and wildlife reference books

GAME VIEWING FROM YOUR OWN VEHICLE: Explore more than 75 kilometres of road through prime wildlife country. There are several lookout points at waterholes in the area. Opening hours change according to season. No reservation required

Conservation fee: R344/adult and R172/child under 12yrs

HOP ON GUIDES ON REQUEST: R240 for 2 hours Qualified rangers will guide you in the comfort of your own vehicle

ADDO PARK SAFARIS

Departs from Addo Elephant Park Reception. Children 6+ years allowed on drives and pay half price. Rate excludes transfers from Woodall. Duration of these safaris is 2 hours. Please check with reception for current times as these change according to season

Sundowner Drive: R570.65/person (R600.95/person from 1 November 2020)

Time: Nov – March: 18h00 – 20h00 April – Oct: (starting time changes according to season.)

Enjoy a sundowner drink while the sun sets after another exciting day of game viewing in Africa. Children 6+ years allowed on drives – pay half price. Possible sightings: Kudu, Red hartebeest, Eland and Duiker Antelopes, Zebra, Buffalo, Jackal, Hyaena, Lions, Birds, Elephant

Night Drive: R444.40/person (R469.65/person from 1 November 2020)

Time: Nov – March: 20h00 - 22h00 April – Oct: 18h00 - 20h00

Lion, Buffalo and Black Rhino and a host of nocturnal animals may be encountered. Possible sightings: Scrub Hare, Spring Hare, Porcupine, Striped Polecat, Spotted Genet, Duiker, Kudu, Eland, Buffalo, Jackal, Hyaena, Lions, Aardvark, Aardwolf, Caracal

Other Drives: R419.15/person (R439.35/person from 1 November 2020)

Possible sightings: Elephants, Warthogs, Ostrich, Red Hartebeest, Kudu, Zebra, etc.

SCHOTIA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE (45 minute drive from Woodall)

"Tooth & Claw" Safari: R2000/person including dinner

Time: 15h00 - 19h00 followed by dinner

Schotia is the oldest private game viewing reserve in the Eastern Cape and offers one of the best chances to see lions in the wild. The Tooth & Claw is a guided drive in open topped vehicles. It begins in the late afternoon and returns after nightfall (late afternoon and evening game viewing is often the most rewarding time of day for game viewing as this is when animals are at their most active). This is especially the case with Lion which are generally nocturnal hunters. Schotia is also home to Zebra, Wildebeest, Warthog, Jackal, Crocodile, Giraffe and a large variety of Antelope. The drive is followed by a traditional meal served under the stars in a thatched open air lapa

AMAKHALA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE (± 1 hour drive from Woodall)

R1700/person Children 6 years+

Time: 9h30

Feel the heartbeat and rhythm of Africa as you become part of a Big 5 Safari Adventure on Amakhala Game Reserve. Guided by experienced rangers on open Land Rovers Amakhala offers a product aimed at providing visitors with an experience of the diverse wildlife and landscape including: The Big 5, Black Wildebeest, Cheetah, Giraffe, Zebra and numerous other Antelope. The excursion commences from Leeuwenbosch Country House with a welcome drink and a Game drive through the reserve enjoying spectacular views. This is followed by a 2 course lunch

PUMBA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE (± 1 hour drive from Woodall)

R1450/adult + R880/child (6 – 11yrs) (0-6 yrs need a private safari) including meal and drinks.

Time: 09h30 – 13h30 (R1565/adult + R950/child from 1 January 2021)

Pumba Day Safaris offer sightings of the Big 5, against a backdrop of thornveld, grassland, thicket and forest vegetation. Apart from White Lion, Giraffe, Leopard, 22 species of Antelope, this is also a bird lovers' paradise with 200 plus bird species. Safaris consist of a 2 hour game drive, meal, drinks then a further one hour game viewing

TOWNSHIP TOURS

R700/person

Time: 4pm to 6pm

Experience Nomathamsanqa Township. Learn about local township life, history of the Xhosa people, Anglo Boer wars, the Frontier wars and the contribution of the citrus farms and Addo Elephant National Park in creating employment. You will experience Shebeen life where you will have a drink at a local tavern with the township folks. Visit the local elders and take photographs with them

HIKING IN THE ADDO AREA

Addo Park Discovery Trail: This unique 2 km trail through typical Addo thicket has been specially designed for disabled visitors and is suitable for wheelchairs

Zuurberg Nature Trails: (1 hour and 3 hours). These trails wind through fynbos and deep kloofs within unspoiled indigenous forests, home to a wide range of game and birds, as well as various vegetation types including impressive cycad and yellowwood populations. Zuurberg is open from 07h00 - 16h30

Conservation fee: R307/adult and R154/child under 12yrs

ADRENALIN ADDO

Zip Line R350/person (Includes Guide and Equipment) 500m long, 60m high, and up to 60km/h

Fast, fun and safe, this exhilarating ride begins from a vantage point 60 meters above the Sundays River, overlooking a valley of citrus. Brave enough to take that initial launch, 500-meter twin zip lines fly two riders over the river at up to 60 km/h. An automatic braking system at the end of the zip means you do nothing but enjoy the ride!

Giant Swing R250/person (Includes Guide and Equipment) 18m high free fall– twice the force of gravity

Adrenalin Addo's Giant swing is the first of its kind in South Africa and guarantees to swing you to new heights. After being hoisted up 18 metres high, the rest is history as they say. A release into oblivion, the sky your limit, this is the ultimate test. Say goodbye to your stomach!

ADDO NATIONAL PARK HORSE TRAILS

Addo Park:

Breathtaking horse trails through Addo allow you to become one with the African bush. In the Nyathi section for the park – encounters with large game are possible. There are no lions or hyenas in this section. Age 10yrs + only

Experienced Riders: R570/person (R616.10/person from 1 November 2020)

Time: 14h00 - 17h00: Three hour guided horse trail within the elephant park with rare opportunities of viewing game close up

Novice Riders: R530/person (R570.65/person from 1 November 2020)

Time: 08h30 - 10h30: Two hour guided horse trail next to the game fence

ADDO ELEPHANT NATIONAL PARK GUIDED MOUNTAIN HIKE – Minimum for 4 persons

R1300/person (including park fees, drinks, snacks, light lunch and transfers to and from Woodall)

Time: 07h30 – 15h00 (R1400/person from 1 October 2020)

Guests will be driven up the Zuurberg Mountain Pass to a remote, pristine, and lush forest section of the Addo Elephant National Park, deep in the heart of the Zuurberg Mountains. From there they will have a guided hike through the Mountains, where they will learn about some interesting plants, whilst enjoying the beauty of the area, within unspoilt nature. This hike is not recommended for the elderly, but is a great way to get out into the Greater National Park and stretch those legs. Drinks and snacks will be provided throughout the hike, and at the bottom of the hike there's a lovely mountain pool to have a swim in. Bring Hat, Sun cream, Sunglasses, Camera, Walking Shoes and Binoculars

ADDO RIVER SAFARI – Minimum of 2 persons

R650/person including transfers from Woodall, snacks and drinks. (R715/person from 1 October 2020)

MORNING PADDLE: 08h30 – 11h30 (05h30 early morning option available in summer)

SUNDOWNER PADDLE: 14h00 – 17h00

Explore a different side of Addo and view game and birds on the riverbanks while you drift down on some of the most scenic parts of the Sunday's River in a custom designed, comfortable and stable canoe (no paddling experience needed). The popular guided Addo River Safari's offers guests the best bird watching in the Eastern Cape, where one can find countless water birds, 7 different species of Kingfisher and chance sightings of the elusive African Fish Eagle and magnificent Goliath Heron. (Bring Hat, Sunglasses, Camera and Binoculars) Waterproof buckets provided

RAGGY CHARTERS (Departs Port Elizabeth Harbour)

Penguin Island Cruise - Minimum of 4 people (No last-minute bookings will be honoured)

R2250/person (includes light refreshments)

Time: 08h30 Duration 3 – 4 hours

Discover the marine life of Algoa Bay off Port Elizabeth, one of South Africa's most diverse bays. Bryde's whales, bottlenose and humpback dolphins can be seen almost all year round; Southern right whales visit every year to give birth to their calves and mate; and humpback whales pass through during their annual migration. Hundreds of common dolphins often come into the bay to feed. Add to this the Cape fur seal, several shark and seabird species, as well as a visit to St Croix Island Reserve to see the largest breeding colony of the endangered African Penguin

Whale Watching Cruise – Minimum 4 people

Rate: R1700/person (No last-minute bookings will be honoured)

A 3 hour cruise to look for humpback or southern right whales which are visiting the bay between June and December. If no whale sightings occur guests will be taken out to St Croix Island to see the penguins. We meet the guests at 8:15am (at ABYC) for an 8:30am departure and usually return by midday (depending on what is spotted). We may see other wildlife on this cruise including dolphins, seals, penguins and other sea birds (but these sightings cannot be guaranteed)
